Christmas Parade Rules

Parade Rules will be strictly enforced

- No Santa Claus -like or Mrs. Claus-like costumes will be allowed in the parade except for the official Santa Claus Float
- Single vehicle entries must be decorated
- The person in charge of the float must remain with the float throughout the parade and must have a cell phone on his/her person. This person and cell phone number must be indicated on the parade registration form
- Participants must maintain forward motion at all times once the parade has begun. No stopping or lagging behind will be allowed unless the parade or entrant in front of you stops
- For any car clubs that are entered in the parade: BURNING rubber or excessive acceleration will absolutely not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from the parade immediately
- No one may leave the parade until it has reached the dispersal area at First Street
- Participants in parade must refrain from smoking and the consumption of alcohol
- Parade participants driving their own vehicle must submit proof of liability insurance with their registration form
- Due to the parade being at dark and wanting to protect everyone involved, we ask that there be no throwing of candy from vehicles. You may hand candy and or other items to spectators by way of someone walking alongside your float or vehicle
- During lineup at the staging area, all entries must be equipped with the following- fire extinguisher, a working horn, proof of insurance, working lights
