Christmas in the Village Lighted Parade Rules:

PLEASE READ

- **1.** No Santa Claus Like or Mrs. Claus like costumes will be allowed except for the official Santa Claus Float.
- 2. Single Vehicle Entries Must be Decorated.
- **3.** The person in charge of the float must remain with the float throughout the parade and must have a cell phone on his/her person. This person and cell number must be indicated on the registration form.
- **4**. Participants must maintain forward motion at all times once the parade has begun. Not Stopping or lagging behind unless the parade or vehicle comes to a stop in front of you.
- **5**. For any car clubs that arE entered in the parade: Burning Rubber or excessive acceleration will absolutely not be tolerated.
- **6.** No one may leave the parade until it has reached the dispersal area after turning right on First Street.
- **7.** Participants in the parade must refrain from smoking and consumption of alcohol.
- **8.** Parade participants driving their own vehicles must be able to provide proof of liability insurance.
- **9**. Due to the parade being dark and wanting to protect everyone involved, we ask that there be no throwing of candy from vehicles. You may hand candy and or other items to spectators by way of someone walking along side your float or vehicle.
- **10.** During line up at the staging area, all entries must be equipped with a fire extinguisher, a working horn, proof of insurance, and working lights.
